Entry fee: £12 for the first pig and £3 per pig thereafter. Maximum of 2 pigs per pen.

Additional pen fee: £5 per pen

Rules:

1. All classes are held under the general rules and conditions recommended by the British Pig Association.
2. Pigs must be in their allocated pens by 9.00am.
3. Judging will commence at 10am. The class order will be displayed in the pig ring
4. Exhibitors may uplift their pigs from 3pm or immediately after all judging is completed, whichever is the later.
5. All pigs must be registered with the BPA or equivalent society.
6. Proper pig boards and sticks are required. Handlers are required to be of smart appearance; white coats must be worn at all times in the show ring.
7. Boars aged 12 months or over must have their tusks cut prior to the show and be shown by two competent adult handlers, both equipped with boards and sticks.
8. Movement licenses must be completed prior to arrival and handed to the pig steward prior to unloading.
9. Entry forms must be completed in full, including registration numbers.
10. Entries to be received by the convenor no later than 20/05/2012
